 Between John Hodge of Sudbury on the one party and Joshua Haynes
 Joseph Noyes John Woodward Noah Clap John Clap Ephraim Curtis
 Select men of y^e Town of Sudbury on y^e other party: the afore said
 Select men finding that Town of Sudbury is in want of a pound and this
 Day a Groom with y^e afore said John Hodge to build a pound for y^e Town
 of Sudbury of seven and thirty foot square with a sufficient number of
 posts on each side of Good white oak posts of seven or eight inches
 square: seven Rails in each pane mortist in at each end excepting the
 top Rail which is to be let in like a plate and to be complet six foot
 and a half high or not l/s: with a Gate four foot wide: not Exceeding nine
 feet between post and post: and to be set up on y^e Norwest side of y^e old
 from y^e Norwest side of y^e old pound: and to be set up and finished by y^e
 twelfth Day of march Next: if the Ground by Reason of frost will admit
 of it: and the said John Hodge is to receive of said Town for y^e afore said
 pound: four pounds and ten shilling: he to bring his bill into said Town
 Next April to be allowed by said Town: with other Town Debt: By way
 of Ingagemen Each party have hear unto set our hands the first Day of
 february: 1721: 2: and in y^e eight year of his majestys Reign

These are to order you to warn y^e freeholders and other Inhabitants of and
 belonging to y^e Town of Sudbury qualified as y^e Law Requires to meet at y^e
 meeting House in Sudbury on Tuesday y^e 24 Day of march Current at Ten
 of y^e Clock forenoon on y^e Day then and there to Elect and Chuse Select men
 Town Clerk Constables assessors: and all other Town officers as y^e Law
 Requires to be Chosen annually in y^e month of march: likewise to see if y^e
 Town will vote that y^e Tithes in Sudbury shall goe all large for this
 present year: and make Return of your Doings hereunto y^e Select men
 or Town Clerk at time and place.
