will Chuse a Committee to prefer a petition to y^e Next Court of Quarter Sessions
to be holden for y^e County of Middlesex: That y^e Stoppage and obstruction upon
Judbury and Concord River may be Removd which we are informed is
upon y^e River in Billerica bounds: which is a hindrance to y^e passage of y^e
fish: And make Return of your Doing here in to y^e select men at time and
place above y^e.
