 of said Judbury on Monday y^e 5th Day of August Next: at one of y^e
 Clock after Noon on said Day to see if y^e town will act and Doe any
 thing either by a petition to y^e General Court or other ways that so the
 petitioners that was laid to y^e town of Judbury: by y^e General Court at
 their sessions in June: 1721: may still be Continued to y^e town of Judbury
 that so y^e town may not be weakened and Disabled as to their publick
 Charges it being very heavy on them: said petitioners having now
 a petition in y^e General Court either that y^e old meeting house on y^e East
 precinct may be Remooved so as to accomodate them in some measure
 according as was promised before they moved to be layed to y^e town
 of Judbury: or Else that they may be layed from Judbury to Natick
 also to see if y^e town will agree and vote that y^e warning for y^e town
 meetings for y^e future may be posted upon both sides of y^e River in each
 precinct at y^e publick meeting houses: fail not to make return of your
 Doeing herein to y^e select men at y^e above said time and place
