to warn of freemen and other inhabitants of and belonging to the town
of Judbury Qualified as by Law Directs to meet at the new meeting house
in the west precinct in Judbury on Monday: 13th Day of January Next
1723:4: at Ten of the Clock fore Noon: So if the Town will proceed
to Chuse a Committee and fully Impower them to agree with workmen
to go on with the work to remove the old meeting house on the East side
of Judbury River to the place where the General Court hath ordered it
it may be Completed by the time that the Court hath permitted and to
agree with James Ross for the Land to set the meeting house on:
Also to so if the Town will order the hundred and fifty pounds that was
Granted by the Town of Judbury: for Repairing the old meeting house in
the East precinct in the Town: To be now Improved and laid out in and
about Removing the old meeting house to the place where the Court
hath assigned and towards Repairing the same: also to so if the Town will
order the Town Treasurer of the Town to pay the hundred and fifty pounds
about so as it becomes Due from the Town: To the Committee that may be
Chosen for Removal of meeting house aforesaid: also to so if the Town take Care
that the Honourable General Courts Committee may be paid as the Court hath
ordered: also to so if the Town will order another fashion Roofs to the meeting
house when removed: also to so if the Town will order the Town Treasurer
of the Town to Deliver or pay so much money as shall be made to
appear to the Town in and about Repairing the old meeting house by
the Committee employed by the East precinct in the Town: also to so if the
Town will agree with John Loker Concerning the Suit Depending between
Constable Joseph parmontor and the Loker: and make Return of your
Doings hearing to the select men or Town Clerk at time and place
Judbury December 30: 1723: by order of the select men of Judbury

And it being orderly put to vote wheather the Town would Chuse
a Committee and fully Impower them to remove the old meeting
house on the East side of River in the Town: at the Towns Cost: according as
the Honourable General Court hath ordered: The Town by a Clear Vote
agreed to it.
