 y^e above y^e Committe are impowred to agree with m^r James Ross for
 y^e land to set said meeting house on: likewise y^e town by a vote
 ordered y^e Hundred and fifty pounds that was Granted by y^e town of
 Sudbury for repairing y^e old meeting house in y^e East precinct in y^e town
 to be now improved and laid out in and about removing said old
 meeting house: to y^e place where said General Court hath assigned
 and towards y^e repairing y^e same: also y^e town by a vote impowred

 said Loker as to Rates: as followeth: Each party to bear their own
 Charges: and y^e Loker to pay y^e Kings Tax that now is in Constables
 parmenters hands: and to pay no more Town Rates to y^e town of
 Sudbury as he now is Circumstanced:
