as by Law Directs: to meet at the meeting House in the West precinct
in said town: on Wednesday the twenty fourth Day of November
Current at Ten of the Clock in the forenoon on the Day then and there
to so if the town will employ and impower men to give in Reasons to the
Honourable General Court in the towns behalf: the: 30: Day of
November Current: if then sitting if not the first Tuesday of the
next Session: why the prayer of a petition Given into the General
Court the: 3: of November Current: by some Inhabitants belonging to
Judbury on the west side of Elzabeth River: praying to be set off from
Judbury and annexed to the town of Stow: praying that all the Lands
on that side of River be set off: and the Inhabitants on that side the River
have their money paid back that they have already paid towards
the building and repairing of a meeting House in the East precinct in
Judbury: also to so if the town will impower each precinct in Judbury
to build Convenient School Houses in each precinct at the Towns
Charge: by raising of money out of the Income of the Bank money that
is or should be in the Trustees hands or the Effects of the old meeting
House: Likewise to so if the town will provide a place or places to keep
School in for the present: And make Return to the select men or
town Clerk at time and place above named
