to make an Answer in the General Court to a petition of John Jones
and others inhabitants of Judbury: on the Northwesterly side of Elsiebeth
River: praying that they may be annexed to the town of Stow

The town likewise Impowred their Committee or the major part of them
to move a petition to the General Court in the towns behalf: or otherwayes
that so said inhabitants may be still Continued to the town of Judbury
and no money may be payed back to said petitioners for building or
repairing the meeting houses: in Judbury

The town by a vote Impowred Each precinct to build Each of them
a School House out of the Interest of the bank money that is or should
be in the Trusters hands: Voted by the town that Each precinct shall
provide a Convenient place or places: for the School master to keep
School in for the present till further order att the towns Cost;
