shillings a Day for their service: All the town meeting voted
by the town: That what money shall be Given by any
person in town or out of the town for Revising the Causeways
the Committee Chosen shall keep a fair list of the Names of
the persons: And of the sum Given: and the towns where they
Dwell: And the Committee shall Give an account to the town
which Causeway long or otherwise it was Given: And the
Committee shall Give in a true and fair account of their
proceeding in the whole of the affair to the town when called
there to by the town

forthwith to Call in the fifth part of the five hundred and Eight
pounds: and pay it into the Treasurer General: as the Law

the town or their order what use money the Trustees have Received
