 May Currant att one of the Clock in the after Noon on sd Day: Then
 and thence to Elect and Deput one or more persons being freeholders
 and Resident in the same town: according to the Number set and
 limited by an act of the General Assembly to serve for and represent
 them in a Grate and General Court or Assembly Appointed to be
 Conuened hold and kept for his majesties service at the Court house
 in Boston: upon Wednesday the last Day of May Currant;
 Likewise to hear Mr Abraham Woods account of what Charge he has
 been at in Relieving Daniel make; in his last sickness and Grant
 what the town thinks Reasonable Also to provide a Grammar School
 master as the Law Directs: Likewise to hear the account of the Comth
 that was employed to make sale of the timber and materials of the
 Old meeting house: and to give them further power if need Requires
 in that affairs: Likewise to see if the town will build a bridge over Elsbeth
 River at the place where it was formerly Granted and built by the
 town as set forth in a petition by several Inhabitants of the Norwest
 Corner of sd town: Also to see what way the town will have their town
 meeting warrned for the future: you are to warn the Inhabitants by
 Going about: a Grateable to the vote of sd town: And make Return
 of this order with your Doing hearin to the select men at time
 and place: Sudbury: May: 2: 1727:
