likewise to bring in town Debt and Credit: also to see if the town will vote  
that their Swins shall God all large this present year: also to see if & town  
will order their Trustees of their five hundred and eight pounds for to

& town will order to each precinct in said Judbury for to build school  
houses agreeable to a former act of & town: also to see if the town will buy  
a suitable Burying Cloath: for & town: and make return of your Doing  
here in to the Select men or town Clerk at time and place above &

being meet at time and place proceeded to Choose John Hayns moderator  
at & town meeting voted that they will Take their part of & sixty  
thousand pounds: lately Granted by the General Court: their part being  
five hundred and Twenty six pounds:  
at the above & town meeting: voted by the town that they will Choose three  
men their Trustees to receive Judburys part of the sixty thousand pounds  
agreeable to the act of the General Court:  
The town by their votes Choose Capt Joshua Hayns their first Trustee  
The town by their votes Choose John Hayns the second Trustee  
The town by their votes Choose Saml John Rica the third Trustee  
voted by the town that the Trustees: set out their money: Not less then  
Ten pounds: and Not more then Twenty pounds the first fort Night  
after the Trustees have received it: publick Notice being Given:  
voted by the town that the Trustees Give an account of their proceeding  
in that affair yearly to the town:  
voted by the town that their Swins shall God all large this  
present year in Judbury
