Day of March next in dueing the Date here of at ten of the Clock in the fore
noon on said Day Then and there to Elect and chuse Selectmen And Town Clerk
Assessors And Constables. And all Other Town Officers that the Law Requires
to be annually chosen in the month of March —

from the Road by Lanham bridge by Elisha House Dwelling House to west meadow and
Lowance meadow as Laid out. and approve there of —

— Like wise to do if the Town will Vote to sell the mills and the Rest of the
Donation Given by Mr. Peter Noyes to the poor of the Town of Sudbury and
Doxier and In power the selectmen to Give a Deed in the Towns Name to Defend
the said Donation a Gainst the succeeding selectmen of said Town —

To any of the heirs of the Donor for seven hundred pounds or more
or to any other person if they will Give more money for said Donation

Or Give the selectmen suitable in Curriagem. to Defend said Donation

Like wise to do if the Town will Give their Town Clerk order to Record the Land
Given to particular men for satisfaction for High ways —

Like wise to hear and act. upon the Return of their Committee Sumtime since
