Ephraim Curtis for his service at the Generall Court the year past. he being already paid out of the province Treasury for his said service) as much for and towards our ministers present half years salary and order their assessors for to make what money may be wanting there for into a rate - - Likewise to hear and Except of the Return of their Committee that was Chosen for to build a bridge over said Sudbury River at the Easterly end of the Long Causeway: and pay them what is yet Remaining due there for out of the Effects of the old meeting House: or other ways - - Likewise to hear the Return of their Committee that was Chosen for to examine into the affairs Relating to the Ministerial Lands and meadows and to act further there in as said Town shall think best: - all so to do if said Town will take Care and order that the ministerial meadows may be made as good and profitable on and for the west side of said Sudbury River as they are on & for if feasible all so to see whether said Town will act or do anything further then what hath been Done in order to secure the money for which the Donation Given to the poor of said Town by Mr. Peter Noyes: given by his Last will & testament was sold for: so as the said money may be kept and all ways improved in and for the End and no other: use: for which said Donation was Given for and make Return of your Doings here in at Time and place to the select men or Town Clerk - - Sudbury October: ye. 17: 1729.
