These are to order you for to warn ye freeholders and other Inhabitants of and
belonging to the westerly precinct in said Sudbury living on the Northerly side
of Lancaster Road. Qualified as the Law Directs for to vote in Town affairs
for to meet at the meeting House in the East precinct in said Sudbury on
Monday ye Twenty seventh Day of October Current at Twelve of the Clock
noon on said Day -- Then and there to take care and provide a Grammar
Schoolmaster for said Town for the year ensuing as the Law Directs
all so to see if said Town will order ye 49 = 0 = 000 money that was
Granted by and assessed upon said Town this present year for the payment
of Capt. Ephraim Curtis for his service at the Generall Court ye year past
hee being all Ready paid out of the province Treasury for his service
as much for and towards our ministers present halfe years salary
and order their assessors for to make what money may be wanting there
for in to a Rate -- Likewise to hear & accept of the Return of

at the latterly end of the Long Cawway and pay them what is yet remain
