At a Town meeting in Sudbury. October. 27th. 1729 the Town being mett Proceeded to the work of the Day and Chose John Moor Moderator
At said meeting Voted to chuse a Committee to provide a Grammar school master to serve the Town the year ensuing

And by their votes Chose } Cap. Joshua Haynes } Committee
for said Committee } Mr. Peter Haynes }

Voted at said Town meeting that the forty nine pounds & four shillings that was Granted for the payment of Ephraim Curtis for his service at the Generall Court be now paid towards the Reverend ministers halfe years salary -- Voted that the assessors make the remaining part of the Eighty pounds in to a Rate -- Memorandum it was included in this vote the Towns willingness that the inhabitants on the west side of Alabath River be by the Assessors of said Town Rated in the next Town Rate as much as they have all Ready paid to the said forty nine pounds & four shillings
