 These are to order you to warn the freeholders and other Inhabitants of and
 belonging to the town of Sudbury Qualified as the Law Directs to meet at a
 meeting house in the west precinct in Sudbury on Friday the fifteenth
 Day of May Current at Eleven of the Clock for noon P. Day: Then and there to Elect
 and Deput on or more persons being freeholders and Resident in P. town according
 to the Number set and limited by an act of the General Court or assembly to serve
 for and represent them in Great and General Court or assembly: appointed to be consumed
 hold and kept for his majesties service at Cambridge upon Wednesday the Twentieth
 fourth Day of May Current: Likewise to see if the town will Choose a Constable
 for the East side of Sudbury River in P. town of Charles Johnson: Likewise to see if the
 town will vote and make the lands and meadows lying in P. Sudbury on west
 side of P. Sudbury River: lying on and joining to P. Easterly End of a meadow Called
 Long meadow Containing about Twelve acres be the same more or less: and is
 bounded as may appear by P. proprietors of the Common Lands in P. Sudbury
 Book of Records: ministeral and lay to and for the use of the ministry in P. Sudbury
 Likewise to see if the town will build a bridge upon the Country road over the brook
 Next above Mr. Abraham Woods mill: Likewise to Call Deacon John Moor their
 late Treasurer to an account: Likewise to see if the town will Choose a Comth or
 agents and Impower them in the towns Name for to Run the bounds of the
 ministeral lands and meadows in P. town with such persons as have their lands
 and meadows adjoining thereto: and further Impower their P. Comth or agents for
 to see and ~~prosecute~~ prosecute in the law: if there be such person or persons as have
 or shall be found in any wise to have made any Inchoement thereon:
 Likewise to hear and act upon a petition of sundry Inhabitants of P. town: to see
 if the town will order that there may be a sufficiency of wood provided for
 each of our Reverend ministers: And also to see if the town will Raise
 each of their ^{or Agents in addition to their salaries} salaries: Till there is an alteration in money or Grain and
 other provision be of a lower and moderate price: And make Return of
 your Doing here in to the select men: at Time and place
