

Judbury May: 15: 1730: All a town meeting legally warned the town
being meet at time and place proceeded to Chuse Mr John Rice Representative
for the town of Judbury. At the above town meeting the town proceeded to Chuse
Insign John Haynes moderator for to Carry on the rest of the work of the town meeting
At the meeting voted by the town that they will Chuse a Constable for the East side of Judbury
River: in the Room of Charles Jonson: it being made Evident that the said Jonson was removed out
of the town: At the town meeting voted by their votes Chuse David Rice Constable
for the East side of Judbury River: and the said David Rice being called up by the moderator
for to declare his Exemption or Non Exemption upon which the said David Rice Refused for
to serve as Constable and paid Down five pounds in money to the town and so was Discharged
Dismissed: And the town proceeded and by their votes Chuse Sam^l Gould Constable for
the East side of Judbury River: and the said Gould being called up after the Chuse by the
moderator for to Declare his Exemption or Non Exemption upon which the said Sam^l Gould
Did Except as Constable: for to serve as Constable in manner as above the said:
Likewise the town at their meeting voted that the lands and meadows lying in the town of Judbury
and on the westerly side of the said Judbury River: lying in and joining to the Easterly End of
a meadow Called and known by the Name of Longe meadow: Containing twelve
acres: be the same more or less: Bounded Southerly and partly westerly by the land
and meadow of Peter Voyse: and partly westerly and Northerly Bounded by the land
of Timothy Mayman: and Easterly Bounded by the land of James Haynes Jun^r: and a
Right way: shall be ministerial and lye to and for the use of the ministry in the town of Judbury
at the above town meeting voted by the town that Mr John Goodnow to provide
so much as may be necessary both of Timber and plank for: and likewise to repair
the Bridge over the brook upon the Country Road Near above the mill Now in the
hands of Mr Abraham Wood: and also voted by the town that their select men shall
agree with the said Goodnow as to price of the work: and likewise: pay him out of the
savings part of the Interest of the Last Bank of five hundred and Twenty six pounds
and likewise order their Treasurers of the said Bank for to Deliver so much of the Interest to the
said select men: as shall be needful for the service: and likewise voted by the town
that the said Goodnow should mend the Great Bridge over Judbury River: and to be paid in
manner as above the said: likewise voted by the town that the Deacon John Moor late Town
Treasurer Record and make up his accounts to and with the present select men
of the town of what money that hath bin: or is in his hands due and belonging to
the town: likewise by their votes Chuse: Capt Ephraim Curtis: Capt David Haynes
and Capt Joshua Haynes their Committee: or agents: and by a vote Did fully
Impower them in the towns Name for to Run and settle the bounds of the
ministerial lands and meadows in the town of Judbury with such persons as have their lands or
meadows lying Next to or adjoining upon the ministerial lands or meadows: And
further the town by a vote Did fully Impower their Town Comth or agents: To sue and
prosecute to Effect in the law: If need be all or any such person or persons as have
or shall be found in any wise to have taken into their possession or improvement
or have made any manner of Infringement: and Impowered to act as occasion may
be in the said affair: and to Render an account to the town of their Doings in the said affair
when Called there to: likewise the Question was put to the town whether they would
act or do any thing upon or in answer to a petition signed Sam^l Graves and
Ten others: Relating to the towns providing of wood for and likewise to raising the
ministers salary &c: it passed in the Negative: John Haynes moderator
