North side of Lanchester Road: Qualified as the Law Directs: to meet
att the meeting house in the west side of the River: in sd town: on
Tuesday the second Day of february Next Enfuwing the Date hereof
att one of the Clock in the after Noon sd Day: then and there to Elect and
Depute one person or more being freeholders and resident in the same town
according to the Number set and limited by an act of the General Court or
assembly: to serve for and Represent them in a Grate and General Court or
assembly appointed to be Conuened held and kept for his majesties service
att the Court House in Boston upon Wednesday the Tenth Day of february
Next Enfuwing the Date hereof: Likewise to see if the town will petition
to the General Court: that the Grate bridge ouer Charls River may
Not be rebuilt in Cambridge: but a ferry Erected instead thereof.
Likewise to see if the town will Doe any thing for or toward the joining
and Clearing of the ministerial meadow att Long meadow: And make
