to be annually Chosen in the month of March: Likewise to see if the town
will Except and Confirm a way laid out by the select men from Lancaster
Road beginning at Peter Plymtons Lane leading into Gulf Neck by David
parmenter and arial whollers by the Draining Ground and so into the
same Road: att Lake End: as laid out by the select men: also to Except and
Confirm a way from the meadow of Peter Plymton and Martha Griffen into
the aforesaid way as laid out by the select men: Likewise to send in their
votes for the Choise of a County Treasurer: Likewise to see if the town will
Except of the satisfaction Given by the select men to Deacon John Clap for
a high way Goong through his Land: and Give order that the same may
Come upon Record: Likewise to see if the town Except and Confirm a high
way laid out by the select men from Non such Round hill to Peter Bents
Likewise to see if the town will order that the school may be for the
future moved into the several Quarters of the town: Likewise to Except
of a high way from Sandy hill: By Paul Brintnells to west meadow as
appears by the proprietors Record: And make Return of this order with
your Doing here in: to the select men or town Clerk at time and place
Sudbury: february: 18: 1730: by order of the select men: Noah Clap town Clerk
