 likewise to see if the town will Discontinue the way by Josiah pratts
 as the select men have ordered: likewise to see if the town will allow
 of satisfaction given by the select men: Given to uriah moor: and
 Saml willis: for high ways through their lands: also to see if the town will
 take some speedy Care: that there be no Land either Common or Country
 Road: at or near the meeting house be Digged and what hath already been
 Digged up: be speedily filled up: and to take Care that the Glasse be
 mended which has been broken on the west side of the River at the
 meeting house: and to know what the town will do with the money that
 belongs to them from the bank: and to pay the Trustees: And make
 Return of this order to the select men at time and place with your
 Doing herein: Sudbury May: 10: 1751
