These are to order you to warn the freeholders and other inhabitants of and belonging
to your Squadron on the North side of Lancaster Road and on the west side Judbury River
Qualified as the Law Directs: to meet at the meeting House in Judbury on the East side of
the River: on Monday the Twentieth Day of May Current: at one of the Clock in the
afternoon & Day: Then and there to Choose one or more persons being freeholders and Resident
in the same town: to serve for and Represent them in a Great and General Court or assembly
appointed to be Convened there on Request for his majesties service at the Court house
in Boston: upon Wednesday the Twenty sixth Day of May Current: Likewise to see if the
town will Discontinue the way by Josiah Prattes as the Select men have ordered
Likewise to see if the town will allow of the Satisfaction given by the Select men to
Uriah Moor: and Sam^l Willis for high ways through their lands. Likewise to see if the
town will Take some speedy Care that there be no Digging up any Land Common or
Country Road: at or near the meeting house on the East side the River or what hath
been Digged up may be filled up: Likewise to see if the town will take Care to Get the
Glasse mended which is broken at the meeting house in the west side the River
Likewise to see what the town will Doe with Interest money which belongeth to the
town from the last Bank: And pay the Trustees: And make return of your Doings
herein to the Select men at Time and place above
Judbury May: 10: 1731

and place as within written: Phineas Haynes Constable for Judbury
May: 17: 1731

Judbury May: 17: 1731 at a town meeting legally warned the town
being met at Time and place proceeded to Choose Mr John Rice
Representative for the town of Judbury:

At the town meeting the town by a vote Choose Cap^t Joshua Haynes
moderator

voted by the town that Sam^l Willis shall have Three Rods for one
in the thirty Rods high way: Next to and Northerly from the high way
leading to Jo Sam^l Willis house: in full Satisfaction for what Land was
taken from said Willis

voted that the town will prevent Damage Coming to the East
meeting House by Ditches: And by a vote Choose: Mr Joseph wait
Ezra Graves: Johnathan Griffon a Committee: To fill up or order
the Ditch to be filled up Twenty foot from the Southwesterly Corner
of the meeting House: and all along on the back side of the said House
And Twenty foot from the Norwesterly Corner of said House: The major
part of the Com^t to see said work Done at the towns Charge:

voted that the Trustees pay in the towns part of the last Bank to the town
Treasurer till further order

voted that the town Treasurer pay to the Trustees: viz: Cap^t Joshua Haynes
Mr John Rice: and John Haynes: four pounds out of the towns part for their
last years service: voted that the town Treasurer Deliver thirty shillings
to the Reverend Mr Loring: to satisfy Mr Minot for preaching the last

141 Sabbath: voted that Noah Clap order the west meeting house Glasse
to be mended at the towns Charge: voted that the Select men Draw the
money out of the town Treasury hand to pay Noah Clap for mending the
meeting house Glasse: voted that the Com^t appointed to Renew the bounds
of the ministerial lands and meadows: by order of the Select men Draw out the
remaining part of the last Bank money out of the town Treasurers hand if
necessary to Go into the Law: The town By a vote Excepted the Satisfaction
Given by the Select men to Uriah Moor
