At a town meeting legally warned the town being met at time and place proceeded to Chuse Mr John Rice: Representative for the town of Sudbury: Also the town proceeded to Chuse Insign John Hayns moderator at ^{meeting} to answer to John ^{and Jonathan} Groites Complaint made by them to ^{the} town concerning a high way laid out through their land to town by a vote Desired the select men of ^{the} town for to lay out ^{the} way in where the proprietors of the Common land in Sudbury have left land for a high way: ^{the} way leads over a place called wales bridge.

Likewise ^{the} town by a vote ordered and Impowered their select men for to adjust and make up an account with: Their Trustees of the first Bank of: 508: viz Capt David Hayns: Lieut John Balcom and Mr Saml Ston: and Give them proper Receipt or Discharges in the Name of the town as occasion may be:
