belonging to Sudbury on the East side of the River Qualified as the
Law Directs to meet at the west meeting House in said Town on Monday
the 3^d Day of December next in evening the Date here of at Town of the
Clock in the fore noon on said Day then & there — — — — —
To see if the Town will Give to the Reverend Mr. William Cook something in
money to make up the Loss of his Barn a Greable to a petition of — — — — —
Sundry Inhabitants of said Town — — — — —
All so to see if the Town will Raise the Reverend Ministers of said Town
Their stalle fallowes Or Give them a Grattuity and order it in to date
as the Town shall think fit — — — — —
Likewise to see if the Town will Grant money for the Support of the
Gram or school in said Town. And Grant money for Righting & Reading
Schools — — — — —
All so to agree further with a Gram or schoolmaster as the Town shall think fit
Likewise to Chuse a Trustee for the Last Bank in the Room & to Supply
the place In said Trust of Mr. John Rice Doreast. as Directed by the act
of the Gen^l Court. — — — — —
all so to Receive the Towns part of the Intrest of the Last Bank of
their Trustees. Viz. Cap^t Joshua Haynes & L^t John Haynes — — — — —
And to pay said Trustees for their past service in that affair — — — — —
Likewise to see if the Town will Incurriage the turning of the Contree Road
in said Town by John Grouts where it is petitioned for By procuring of Land
of L^t Samuel Graves John Groust & Joseph Larmenter for said Contree Road
And order the selectmen to Lay out said Road — — — — —
All so to a Greewith Cap^t Daniel Estabrook Mr. David Baldwin & Ezra Graves
or others to a sufficient Road over the Brook and all the new Road
to be made Good for Teams to pass in & kept in Good Repair for Twelve years
Or Twenty pounds — — — — —
And appoint a man or men to Inform the Certs Committee that they may
make Report in favour to said Road To prevent further charge — — — — —
Or order the old Road to be made Good & kept in good Repair — — — — —
And make Return of this order with } By order of the selectmen
your Dings here in to the selectmen } of Sudbury: Ephraim Curtis Town
or Town Clerk at time & place — — — — — Clerk
