the Town being met proceeded and Chose Mr. Noah Clap Moderator
at said meeting the Town voted that they will do something in order
to make up the Reverend Mr. Cooks Loss
Voted at said meeting to Give the Reverend Mr. William Cook Twenty pounds
in money towards making up the Loss of his Barn
Voted at said meeting to Give the Reverend Ministers of said Town
Twenty pounds. Each a Grattuity in money for the present year Ending with
April 1734: And voted the Assessors of said Town make it into a Rate
All so voted that the Twenty pounds Given to the Reverend Mr. William Cook
to make up his Loss be added into the afore said Rate
At said meeting Granted by the Town forty five pounds in money for the
support of the Grammar school in said Town & to be added
in to the Ministers Rate
at said meeting Granted by the Town Twenty pounds in money for the
promoting of Reading & Righting schools in the out Quarters of the
Town -- and to be added to the afore said Rate
at said meeting The Town Chose Mr. Kindal their present Schoolmaster
to keep the Grammar school all so Reading & Righting English in said
Town after his present Quarter is Ended: another Quarter of a year
after the Rate of fifteen pound a Quarter Mr. Kindal Accepted
At said meeting the Town Chose Mr. Thomas Tayler a Trustee
for the Last bank in the Room of Mr. John Rice Deceased
The Town by a vote allowed the work of the Day to be Good all
though one of the Constables orders of the Town meeting was
missing after the Town had Accepted of the Constables Return
at said meeting a vote was called to so if the Town will do any
thing to incurriage the turning of the Centre Road by John Grouts
where it is positioned for & it passed in the Negative
At said meeting a vote was called to so if the Town will order
the old Road to be made good & kept in Good Repair after Debate
it passed in the Negative
