To Mr. William Moore one of the Constables of Sudbury Greeting &c
These are to order you to warn the freeholders & other inhabitants of and belonging to said Town on the west side of the River & in the South Constables ward: Quallified as the Law Directs to meet at the next meeting to be in Sudbury on Monday the fourth Day of March next in the forenoon at Ten of the Clock in the morning then & there To Chuse & select men
2. Town Clerk 3. Town Treasurer 4. Assessors 5. Constables —
6. And all other Town officers as the Law Requires to be annually chosen in the month of March —
7. Likewise to bring in their votes for the choice of a County Treasurer
8. Likewise to do if the Town will accept of and confirm a high way Laid out by the selectmen on the west side the River in said Town to accomodate Elias Moore James Brewer juner & Cornelias Goodenow to go to meeting &c all so for their accomodation for watering their Cretors all to two other high ways in Gulf neck to accomodate severall persons in said Town for carting of hay —
Likewise to do if the Town will in carriage the Turning of the Centre Road by John Grouts where it is positioned for by ordering proper meathods for the accomodation of the same or order the old Road by John Grouts to be made good & kept in Repair —
And make Return of this order with your Doings here in to the selectmen or Town Clerk at Time & place —

At a Town Meeting in Sudbury upon a adjournment from March 4th 1733/4 to March 5th 1733/4 The Town being met at time & place adjourned to The severall Town officers here after named were Chosen into their severall offices.
