To Mr Daniel Woodward one of the Constables of Judbury Greeting
This is to Order you warn the freetholders and other inhabitants of our
belonging to the west side of the River: and on the Northerly Constable
ward to ~~be~~ Qualified as the Law Directs: to meet all the East meeting
meeting house: in the town: on Monday the first Day of April Next
Enfuing the Date hear of: at Eleven of the Clock for Noon the Day
then and there to bring into the town Debt and Credit: Likewise to see if the
town will give the Reverend ministers of the town a Gratuity as the town
thinks fitt: and order the assessors to add it into their Rates the enfuing
year: Also to employ men to take care of the meeting houses the enfuing
year: and Dig Graves as there may be Occasion: Also to see if the town will
vote that the Swine in the town may Goe at Large the year Enfuing
Likewise to see if the town will employ a man or men to Repair the meeting
Houses in the town: Likewise to provide a Grammar School master for the town
as the Law Directs: Also to see if the town will Chuse a Comth to sell so
much of the New Grant high ways as they shall think proper for the
use of the town: And if there is any persons that have been in the
possession of any of the said high ways more then three years: that the
Comth Chosen may be Impowred to sue them out: Excepting what the
town has already Disposed of: And make return of this Order with your
Doing hearin to the select men or town Clerk at time and place:
