To Mr Daniel Woodward one of the Constables of Judbury Greeting
These are to order you to warn the freeholders and other inhabitants of and belonging
to Judbury: on the west side of the River: and in the North Constable ward
Qualified as the Law Directs: To meet at the East meeting house in town
on Monday the third Day of March next in the forenoon at 10 o'clock: all men of
the Clock in the forenoon & Day: then are to Elect and Chuse select
men: and town Clerk: Town Treasurer: Assessors: Constable: And all other town
officers as the Law requires annually to be Chosen in the month of March
Likewise to see if the town will order the New way laid out by a jury by John
Grants in Judbury: to be forth with made by setting out or any other way
more a Goodable to said town: also to Grant money to pay the several men
their Damages for their Land taken from them by a jury to accommodate
said way: or to see if the town will Chuse a Com^{tee} to prefer a petition in the
towns Name to the General Sessions of the peace next to be holden at
Charlston for the County of Middlesex: to see if the town can have the
Highway altered by John Grants and the Old way Continued as it was
Likewise to see if the town will Except of a High way laid out by the select men
of Judbury going from said town to Lanham: part of the way through
the Land of Mr John Goodnow and partly through the Land of Isaac
Road: And to Discontinue the Old Road and Give them in Exchange
for the aforesaid Highway: Likewise to see if the town will Except of a High
way laid out by the select men of Judbury: partly through the Land of
Benjamin Dudley: in the Road leading from Judbury to Watick
And to see if the town will Discontinue the Old Road in said Dudley Land
from where the New Road begins to where it Ends: and Give it to Benjamin
Dudley in satisfaction for the New Highway: and make Return of your
Doing here in to the select men or town Clerk: at time and place
