Cap Brintnol shop stood untill its Comes to malbrough Road The same width
as the fences now stands
also to see if the town will accept and Confirm a way laid out by the select men
beginning at malbrough Road at Mr Abraham Woods shop untill its Comes to
Linet John Hayns
also to see if the town will accept and Confirm several Returns of High ways
laid out by the select men more then what is above mentioned
Likewise to see if the town will answer a petition of Amos Smith and others
as to Remove the Grammar School into the several Remote parts of the town
for the future and make Return of this order with your Doing herein to the
select men or town Clerk at time and place above mentioned
