These are to order you to warn the freeholders and other Inhabitants of and belonging to Judbury on the East side the River: Qualified to vote in town affairs To meet at the East meeting house in Judbury: on munday the twelveth Day of Aprill Next Ensuing the Date hear of Ten of the Clock fore Noon to Day Then and there To bring in town Debt and Credit: to to town
Like wise to so if the town will Give the Reverend ministers a Gratuity the year Ensuing: Like wise to so if the town will provide a Grammar School master for the year Insuing: and Grant money for the support of the School Also to so if the town will Grant thirty pounds the Remaining part of sixty pounds agreed for the year past with our present School master mr Kindell: Also to so if the town will appoint persons to take the Care of the meeting houses the Ensuing year: also to Dig Graves as there may be occasion Also to so if the town will vote that the Swine may Goe all Large the present year in Judbury: Like wise to so if the town will make mr Heards a further Consideration for what he has ~~had~~ Don in making of the way by John Grants in Judbury: Also to so if the town will order any thing further for the perfecting of to way: Like wise to so if the town will Discontinue part of the right way formerly laid out by the select men of Judbury: that Goeth over whales Bridge unto the pine plain to Linet Elisha Rices: to wit that part of to way within Jonathan Grants fence: and Give that Land within to Grants fence to him the to Jonathan Grant in satisfaction for what Land was taken from him for the accomodating of the New way last laid out by the select men of Judbury
Likewise to so if the town will Grant money to purchase a bell in answer to a petition presented to the select men by Linet Haynes and others and Chuse a man or men to manage to affair: also to so if the town will Doe any thing to encourage the killing of Black birds and jayes
And makes return of this order to the select men at time and place
