To our Daniel Wages on of the Constables in Judbury Greeting
 these are to order you to warn the freeholders and other inhabitants of and
 belonging to Judbury on the west side the River and in the North Constables were
 Qualifie to vote in town affairs to meet at the East meeting hall in town
 on Monday the twelveth Day of April: Next Insuing the Date Hereof: Ten of
 the Clock fore Noon To Day then and there: To bring in town Debt and Credit to town
 Likewise to see if the town will Give the Reverend ministers a Gratuity & Enfring your
 Likewise to see if the town will provide a Grammar School master: for the year Insuing
 and Grant money for the support of the school
 Also to see if the town will Grant thirty pounds the Remaining part of sixty
 pounds agreed for the year past with our present School master Mr Kendall
 Also to see if the town will vote that the Swine may Goe off Long the present year
 in Judbury: Likewise to see if the town will appoint persons to take the Care of the
 meeting houses the present year: and to Dig Graves as may be occasion
 Likewise to see if the town will make Mr Heard a further Consideration: for what he
 has Done in making of the way by John Grants in Judbury: also to see if the town will
 order any thing further for the perfecting of said way
 Likewise to see if the town will Grant money: to purchase a Bell in answer to a
 petition preferred to the select men by Linet Hays and others: and to Choose a man
 or men to manage that affairs: Likewise to see if the town will Discontinue part
 of the high way formerly laid out by the select men of Judbury: that Goes over
 whals Bridges unto the pine plain: to Linet Bliska Rices: to wit that part of it
 way within Jonathan Grants fence: and Give that Land witten to Grants fence
 to him the said Jonathan Grants in satisfaction for what Land was Taken from him
 for the accomadating the New way last laid out by the select men of Judbury
 across part of said Grants Land: also to see if the town will Incurrag the killing
 of black birds and jays: And make Return of this order to the select men:
