These I do order you to Warn the freeholders and other  
Inhabitants of and Belong to <sup>in your Squadron</sup> So Town Qualifid as the Law  
Directs to Note In town Affairs to Meet at the meetinghouse  
on y<sup>e</sup> West Side of Sudbury on Wednesday the twenty sixth day  
of April Next at ten o'clock forenoon To Day then &  
there to See if y<sup>e</sup> town Will Bring In there Town Debt &  
Credit

Likewise to See if y<sup>e</sup> Town Will Give their Reverend Minister  
A Gratuity for this Present year

Likewise to See if y<sup>e</sup> Town Will Choose a Com<sup>tee</sup> to Provide a  
Grammar Schoolmaster for So Town for y<sup>e</sup> year In suing

Also to See if y<sup>e</sup> town Will Raise Money to Support So School

Also to See if y<sup>e</sup> Town Will Raise Money to Support y<sup>e</sup> Schools  
In y<sup>e</sup> Roman Parts of y<sup>e</sup> So Town
