for y^e Present year

2 At y^e above So: Meeting y^e Inhabitance of y^e town
Voted that No Ram or Rams shoud goe at Large
In y^e Sudbury from and After y^e first day of
September Next Ensuing to twentieth day
of November Next In this Present year
and that if any Ram or Rams shall bee
going at large In y^e time above So: In y^e Sudbury
Such Ram or Rams shall forfeit y^e one moiety
therof to him or them that shall Take up y^e
same and y^e other moiety for and to y^e use
of y^e Poore of y^e town of Sudbury

These are to Order you to Warn all the free-holders and other
Inhabitants of and belonging to Sudbury, In your Squadron
qualified as the Law directs to Vote in Town Affairs, to meet
at the East Meeting-house in Sudbury, on Monday the fifth Day
of March next, at Nine of the Clock forenoon, then & there to
Chose Select-men Town Clerk, Town Treasurer, Assessors, Con-
stables, and all other Town Officers as the Law directs, Annually
to be Chosen In the Month of March &c. And make return
of this Warrant or Order with y^e Doings herein. To y^e Select-
men, or Town Clerk, at time & Place above mentioned.
