Those are to Order you forthwith to warn all the Freeholders and other Inhabitants of S^d. Town In your Ward qualified as the Law directs to vote in Town Affairs that they meet at the East Meeting house In S^d. Town on Thursday the Seventeenth Day of May Current at one o' Clock Afternoon then & there to Elect & Depute One or more Meet Person or Persons to Serve & Represent S^d. Town in the great & General Court or Assembly to holden at the Court house in Boston on Wednesday the Thirtieth day of May Current conformable to the Precept.
2. To See if the Town will vote to have y^r. whole Years Rates made in the Fall of the Year And bring in y^r. Debts & Credit in the Fall of the Year for the future - Agreeable to a Petition of Sundry of the Inhabitants of S^d. Town.
3. To See if the Town will Reconsider the Vote y^r. was passed in April last Relating to Moving the Grammar School into the Several parts of S^d. Town as Usual And Grant money for the Support of it.
4. To See if the Town will Grant a Sufficiency of money to Support the Schools in the Remote Parts of the Town for the Year ensuing Agreeable to a Petition of Several of the Inhabitants of S^d. Town.
