Pursuant to the within Order I have warned all the Freeholders and other Inhabitants belonging to my Squadron to meet at time & place within mentioned.

To M^r. Joseph Parmenter one of the Constables of Sudbury Greeting These are to Order you forthwith to warn all the Freeholders & other Inhabitants of S^t. Town In your Ward qualified as the Law directs to vote in Town Affairs if they meet at the East meeting house in S^t. Town on Thursday the seventeenth Day of May Current at one of y^e Clock Afternoon then & there to Elect & Depute one or more Meet Person or Persons to Sew & Represent S^t. Town at the Great & General Court or Assembly to be holden at Boston Court house upon Wednesday the thirtieth Day of May Current Conformable to the Precept.

- 2 To See if the Town will vote to have y^e whole years Rates made in the Fall of the year - And bring in y^e Debts & Credit in the Fall of the year for the future; Agreeable to a Petition of Sundry of the Inhabitants of S^t. Town.
- 3 To See if the Town will reconsider the vote it was passed in April last, relating to the Moving the Grammar School into the several Parts of S^t. Town. And to See if they will vote to settle the School in S^t. Town as usual And grant money for the Support of it.
- 4 To See if the Town will grant a Sufficiency of Money to Support the Schools in the remote parts of the Town for the ensuing year. Agreeable to a Petition of Several of the Inhabitants of S^t. Town.
- 5 To See if the Town will Allow M^r. Benj^a. Barron the Land allowed by the Select men, as a Recompence for the Land the Town have had of him for a high way.
- 6 To See if the Town will Discontinue the Old high way by M^r. John Grout's, & Chuse & Impower a Committee to Sell S^t. Old high way to the best Advantage.
- 7 To See if the Town will Discontinue the high way leading from the County Road to Natick Road beginning at Bent's Corner. And Chuse & Impower a Committee to Sell S^t. high way to the best Advantage. And make return of this Order with y^e Doings herein to the Select men, or Town Clerk at time & place Above mentioned.
