

Sudbury May 17th 1739

- At a Meeting of the Inhabitants of S. Town Legally warned and
Assembled. S. Town proceeded & Voted as follows viz^t W^m. Uriah Moor Mod^r.
1. M^r. Edward Sherman y^r. Representative for the Present Year.
2. Voted that y^r. whole Years Rates be made in the Fall of the
Year: And y^r. their Debts & Credit be brought in, in the Fall of
the Year for the future.
3. Voted That the Article relating to the moving y^e Grammar
School shall not be reconsidered. Voted £72:0-0 for the
Support of the School the Ensuing Year, And that it be made into
a Rate with the Other Town Rates.
4. Article Negatived.
5. Voted That M^r. Benj^a. Barron have the Land allowed by the
Select men, Only reserving the East Side of the North Piece,
The Sixth & Seventh Articles Negatived.
