In Obedience to this Warrant I have warn'd the Freeholders & other Inhabitants in my Ward to meet at time & Place according to the custom of the Town. Joseph Parmenter One of the Constables of Sudbury. The other two Constables viz. M^r Daniel Haynes & M^r Thomas Collier their Return of their Warrants were the same.

At a Meeting of the Inhabitants of S. Town Legally warn'd, and Regularly Assembled. S. Town proceeded & voted as follows. viz. Cap^t John Haynes Moderator.

Deer-Reeves Leib^t Gould East. M^r Samuel Robins. West.
