 and one Cart and Wheel at 9-1-6 per Day and that Each
 Person have liberty to work out there Above Td. Rates at the high
 ways in Td. town at the Price above Perfixt Provided they appear
 at Six days warning and do the Labour as above
 Voted By Td. town that for Each Black bird or Jay Bird that Shall
 Be killed within the Bounds of Td. town there Shall Be allowed
