 Belonging To Sudbury In your ward Qualified as the Law Directs to vote in
 Town affairs to meet at the last meeting house In Sudbury on Monday the Seventh
 Day of March next at Ten of the Clock fore noon
 Then and there To Chuse selectmen. Town Clerk. Assessors. Town Treasurer
 Constables. and all other Town officers Annually to be Chosen In the month of March
2. To see if the Town will accept of a highway Laid out by the selectmen of Sudbury
 Between the Land of Joseph Maynard and Thomas Brigham agreeable to the Directions
 of Said town at their meeting May y^e 20th 1742.
 3. To see if the Town will accept of a highway Laid out by the selectmen of Sudbury
 from the Centre Road near the Town Bridge to Fegmeadow Lots
 4. For to see if the Town will accept of a highway Laid out by the selectmen of
 Sudbury Between the Land of Jonathan Ruffer and the greater meadow Lots the highway
 is Two Rod wide: All so to see if the Town will Quit their claim to Jonathan Ruffer
 to the Remaining part of the vic Road formerly Left for a highway as far as it lieth
 against Said Ruffer Land. And make Due Return of this order and your Doings
 here in to the selectmen
