Boston upon Wednesday the Twenty Fifth Day of May Carrant. by Nine of the Clock in
the morning and So. To. Die. in. Diem During their session and sessions
All so to see if the Town will proceed to Build a work house according to
a former Vote of the Town and in what place and Dementions
and to see if the Town will Grant. Money to Build and finish said house and in
what meathard the Town will perdue to Effect. the same
all so to see if the Town will Give leave to Eliab Moore to Set up Gates or
Convenient Bars at Each End of a high way Laid out by the selectmen from the
