in Town affairs to meet at the Eastmeeting House in Andbury on Monday
the Tenth Day of October next. at one of the Clock in the after noon
at then and there.

1. To bring in to said Town Town Debts and Credit.
2. To see if the Town will Grant their Reverend ministers a Grattuity for the
year Inchoing Includging their fire wood
3. To add it to the ministers Rate and order said Rate to be made as soon as may be
4. To Chuse men to take Care of and sweep the meeting Houses in said Town the year
Inchoing. all to take Care of the school Houses and Dig Graves as ther may
be occasion
5. To Grant money for the support of the school or schools as the Town shall
see cause when met.
6. To provide a Grammar schoolmaster for said Town the year Inchoing & order
where said school or schools shall be kept. the Inchoing year
7. To Grant money for the support of Poor People in said Town
and to be Drawn out. By the selectmen of said Town for their Relief
8. To see if the Town will Repaire the House Johiah Prat Lines in
And make Due Return of this order and your Doings here in to the
selectmen or Town Clerk at Time and Place
