ward Qualified as the Law Directs to vote in town affairs
to Meet at the West Meetinghouse in Sudbury on Monday
y^e 18th Day of May Current at one o'clock after Noon
Then & there to Elect & Depute one or more Persons or
Persons Being free holders & Proprietors in the same town to
Represent them in a Great and General Court to Be Convened
at & Propt for his Majesties service at the Court house in
Boston on Wednesday the twentyth seventh Day of May Current at
Nine o'clock forenoon and So to Die Divin During their sessions &
also to see if the town will by their vote order that y^e Swine in y^e
Town may goe at Large y^e year ensuing and Make Due Return at
time & Place By order of y^e Selectmen
