 Petition of Comth Richard Taylor and others or Dispose of y^e Land
 any other way as the town shall think fitt.
 - 7 To Se if y^e town order Where the Grammar School Shall Be
 kept y^e year Ensuing and Grant money for the Support of same
 - 8 to Se if y^e town will order Lanham Bridge to Be New Buelt and
 Grant Money for the same
 - 9 To Se if the town will Grant money for to Pay the assessors & town
 Treasurers y^e year Ensuing
 - 10 To Se if y^e town will Move the Schoolhouse which Stand Near
 the East Meeting house Or Near to Dea Browers or where
 the town Shall think fitt for y^e Bonifit of y^e town In answer to
