

- 3 To Se if the town Will Remove the Schoolhouse By the East meeting house from y^e Place where it Now stands to or as Near Dea. Brewers as may Be or where y^e town think fit. In Answer to a Petition of Dⁿ Daniel Noyes and others
- 4 To Se if the Town Will Accept of a highway Laid out By the Selectmen of S^dbury on y^e West Side of River it. Being Chiefly Land Left by the Proprietors to Accomodate the Owners of the Land and Meadows on and About Haywards Island So Laid Beginning at y^e Side of the meadow on the North Side of Gulf Brook Running Northwardly By the West End of the River Meadow Lots untill it Comes to the Southerly End of y^e first Division Lots Then Running Westerly By the South End of said Lots till Comes to the World End Meadow then Southerly By the World End meadow till it Comes to the South End of S^t. - 6 To Se if the town Will Accept of a highway Laid out By the Selectmen of S^dbury Beginning at a highway Leading over a Bridge near W^r. Sharman on the East Side of Nathan Maynards fence Running Northerly and So on untill it Comes to the Southeasterly Corner of S^t. Daniel Noyes Meadow
- 7 To Se if the town Sell to W^r. John Groat the old Highway Leading the John Groat's former Dwelling house and Chup a ^{part} of the same
- 8 To Se if y^e town Will Give Liberty to Capt. Josiah Richardson and others to Cut up the two hind Seals in the Bay of Seats in the West Meeting house in S^dbury and Build Pies therein for them selves and there families for their Innd house In answer to a Petition of S^d Capt. Richardson and others
- 9 To Se if the town Will order the Selectmen of S^dbury to Adjust the towns Debts for the year Ensuing and to Be Laid Before the town for Acceptance
- 10 To Se if y^e town Will Choose an Agent or Agents & fully Impower him or them in y^e Behalf of S^d town to Proceed to Eject and final house Boll Belonging to S^d town Now hanging on the ^{Separation} East meeting house in S^d town
- 11 To Se if the town Will allow of the Satisfaction Laid out by the Selectmen in the West thirty Rod Highway to S^t. Daniel Noyes for a highway Laid out Throug h^{is} Land By the Selectmen of S^dbury to W^r.
