These are To Order you to Warn all the freeholders and other
Inhabitants of and Belonging to Sudbury in your Ward Qualified
as the Law Directs To Vote in town Affairs to Meet At the West
Meeting house in Sudbury on Monday the fifteenth day of May
Current at one o'clock after Noon Then & there to Elect &
Depute one or more Person or Persons Being freeholders &
Resident in the same town To Represent them in a grate
and General Court to Be Convened held & kept for his
Majesties Service at the Court house in Boston on Wednesday
the thirtysixth day of May Current at nine o'clock forenoon
and To be die in diem during their Session & Sessions —
