Then By a Vote of y^e Town the Article for Seating y^e Meeting

It was Put to Vote at y^e Meeting whether the town would act
on y^e Affair of Pulling down the two town Schoolhouses in

at y^e meeting a Vote was Called for on y^e Affair of Boulding
a Row or seats over y^e mens Staves and it Passed for Negative
