

Sudbury May 21: 1750

At a Town Meeting Legally warned the Qualified Voters being met
Proceeded to the work of the Day and Chose Mr. William Rice their Representative
for the year ensuing

At said meeting the Town Proceeded and Chose Ephraim Curtis Moderator
at said meeting the Town by vote gave Leave that the wine in said Town
may goe at Large the year ensuing

At the a fore said Town meeting May 21: 1750. the Town discontinued
the Two high ways in the new Grant. of two miles addition to the Town of Sudbury
for their further enlargement. (to wit) the high way thirty Rods in width Running from
South to north of said Town joining to the old Town all to the high way Running
from the south side of said Town Between the Two Ranges of Grant Lots to the
north side of said Town as set forth in the warning of said meeting and Petitioned
for by John Hayes & others Excepting so much in each of the afore said highways
as the Towns Committee (viz) Ephraim Curtis Thomas Danson & Jonathan Smith
shall judge needfull still to Leave for high ways for the Towns use
all so the Town at said meeting discontinued the high way of thirty Rods
in width Running near East & west throu the Two miles Last Granted the Town of
Sudbury Excepting four Rods in width all along the afore said high way where
the afore said Committee shall judge Best for the Towns use and to Give Lawfull
Deeds in the Towns name of the Rest of the afore said highways

At said Town meeting May 21: 1750 the Town discontinued three Rods in
width of the high way that was left six Rods wide formerly by the Town of
Sudbury at the head of the River meadow Lot on the west side the River from
the Gravel pit so far as to the Brook by Mr. Phineas Haynes the three Rods to
be left where the selectmen shall judge most convenient for the Publick use
and the Town further Proceeded and Chose a Committee & fully Inpowered them or
the major part of them to sell the three Rods in width of the afore said highway
that is discontinued and to Give a Lawfull Deed or Deeds in the Towns name
the money to be applied for the Towns use and Chose for their Committee the present
selectmen (to wit) Mr. Edward Harmon Dea. Josiah Haynes En. Samuel Dakin
Jacob Moore. Daniel Goodenow Hopestill Bent Joseph Linermore

Sudbury October 4: 1750

To Mr. Daniel Moore one of the Constables of Sudbury &c. These are to order you
to warn all the free holders & other Inhabitants of & belonging to Sudbury in your ward
Qualified as the Law Directs to vote in Town affairs to meet at the west meeting House in
Sudbury on Monday the fifteenth Day of October. Current. at Ten of the Clock in the
fore noon

1. To Bring in Town Debts and Credit
2. To see if the Town will give their Rever. ministers a Honourable Gratuity for year ensuing
3. To see if the Town will Chuse a Committee to provide a Grammar Schoolmaster for year ensuing
4. To see if the Town will Grant money for the support of the Grammar School in said Town year ensuing
5. To see if the Town will order where the Grammar School shall be kept
6. To see if the Town will Grant money for the support of Reading & writing schools in said Town the year ensuing And order where said schools shall be kept
7. To see if the Town will Grant money to pay their Assessors & Town Treasurer this present year when it Becomes Due &c
8. To appoint a man to take Care of each meeting House & sweep them the year ensuing
9. To hear the Report of the Towns Committee appointed to a Compt. with the severall Town Treasurers &c and Dig Graves as there may be occasion
10. To see if the Town will Grant money to pay the Last Jury for Estimating the Damages in the way by Mr. Estabrook and Mr. John Clap &c
11. To see if the Town will Grant money to Eject any parson or parsons out of possession that have got any of the thirty Rod high ways into their possession with out the Towns Leave in the new Grant to enable the Towns Committee to proceed in the sale of said Land according to Town orders
12. To see if the Town will Grant money for to Build or Repair the Town Bridge at the Longe Casaway; all to appoint a Committee to see the work or get it done in the best & Cheapest manner &c
