To Mr. Daniel Moore one of the Constables of Sudbury &c

These are to order you to warn all the free holders & other Inhabitants of and Belonging to the north Constables ward on the East side the River in said Town Qualified as the Law Directs to meet at the west meeting house in said Town on Wednesday the fifteenth Day of May Current. at one of the Clock in the after noon. then and there to elect & Depute a man or men being free holders & Resident in said Town to serve for and represent them at Great & Generall Court. or assembly to be Convened held and kept for His Majesties service at the Court House in Boston on Wednesday the twenty ninth Day of May Current. by nine of the Clock in the morning and to De. die: in Diem During their session & sessions &c

1. To see if the Town will accept of such pardons to serve as Jurors as are Put in to the Box for the superiour Court: all so such pardons as are for the Inferiour Court: And Court of Generall sessions of the peace: as put in the Box by the selectmen &c as appears by a List here with Exhibited
2. To see if the Town will by a Vote Give Leave that the swine in said Town may Go at Large the year Inueing
3. To see if the Town will by a Vote Grant such Sums of money as shall be necessary to repair their high ways the Current year. and order the assessors to assess the Town for the same having Reference to such work as has been Done since the first of March last past and state the wages for a Day work and so in proportion to an hour. and the surveyors of the respective ward (or wards) To be the Judges of the Quantum Meriet of such services &c the surveyors giving a Certificate under their hands as the Town shall order

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
