2. To hear the Report of the selectmen as to their proceeding in gaining of seven pounds & Ten shillings Lawfull money for^d Town and to pay them for their Time & Expence as the Town shall think fit.
3. To see if the Town will Give their Rever^d Ministers a Honourable Grattuity for y^r year Insueing
4. To see if the Town will Grant money for the support of the Grammar school in P^r Town y^r year Insueing
5. To see if the Town will order where the Grammar school shall be kept in said Town the year Insueing
6. To see if the Town Grant money for the support of Reading & writing Schools in said Town the year Insueing and order where said schools shall be kept.
7. To see if the Town will Chuse a Committee to Provide a Grammar schoolmaster for^d Town y^r year Insueing
8. To see if the Town will Grant money to pay their officers & Town Treasurer this present year when it becomes Due
9. To see if the Town will appoint to each meeting House a man to take care of them & order to be swept in a Decent manner: And to Dig Graves Graves as there may be occasion
10. To see if the Town will Grant money for the releaf of the Poor in said Town for y^r Insueing year &c
11. To see if the Town will Grant money to Repair the meeting House or Houses in P^r Town & appoint a man or men to do the work
12. To see if the Town will Grant money to procure a Buring Cloth for the Use of the Town and order a man to be it
13. To see if the Town will Grant money any further sum of money for the Repairing of the Highways in P^r Town
14. To see if the Town will Grant money to procure a new Cushion for the west meeting House Pulpit. and order a man to be it
