

Sudbury February 27. 1752.

- To Mr. Daniel Moore one of the Constables of Sudbury. These are to order you to warn all the free holders & other Inhabitants of and belonging to Sudbury In your ward Qualified as the Law Directs to vote in Town affairs to meet at the next meeting House in Sudbury on Monday the second Day of March next at seven of the Clock in the forenoon
1. To Chuse Selectmen: Town Clerk: Town Treasurer: Assessors: Constables: And all other Town officers as the Law Directs to be Chosen annually in the month of March
 2. To see if the Town will accept of a highway or Town way laid out by the selectmen on the west side of the River Between the Land of Capt. Richardson & Mr. Clap to running westward to Abiel Haydens: also a Town way from the way by Capt. Richardsons a Cross Green Hill by Josiah Proats place where the Proprietors Left Land &c
 3. To see if the Town will accept vote that the sheep in said Town may go at Large any part of the Time between the fifteenth Day of March & the fifteenth Day first Day of May next
 4. To see if the Town will accept of a high way as the selectmen have laid it out by Ctmoor Sanders is and give him the old way in Exchange &c
 5. To see if the Town will by a vote free Mr. Olybrow from highway work in consideration of his Extraordinary Charge in making & mending the way from Capt. Segers to the high way in Lanham in his own Land
 6. To see if the Town will Discontinue a high way from time past laid out by the selectmen of Sudbury between the Land of Joseph Goodenow and y^e Land formerly Jonathan Grants and accept of the old Town way in Lne there of so that the way first laid out and discontinued may for the future and Remain an open Town way as it was first laid out and the way discontinued to give in Exchange to Eliak Moore in satisfaction for his Right in the old Town way &c
 7. To see if the Town will Discontinue a high way formerly laid out by the selectmen of said Town and accepted by the Town Leading over whales Bridge onto the pine plain To Discontinue that part of said way from the Range way where it goes in Mr. Heards field till it comes into the Range way a Gain and the said Range way being formerly given in Exchange for that part of said way
 8. To hear & accept the Report of the Comitte chose and Impowered to sell one & direct any person or persons out of Possession any of their Thirty Rod high ways in the New grant or Land called Howfar they have proceeded what they have Expended and if the Town will Dismiss them And Chuse a new Comitte and Impower them to prosecute that affair to full Effect in the Law or Examine all papers & Records touching the Principles and Report to the Town at their next Town meeting what is further proper to be Done thereon in that affair or other ways to Impower said Comitte to Accomodate & agree all Disputes and Controversies subsisting in the Law or in the Town Respecting any or all highways or Land left for highways or other Publick uses within the said Town
 9. To see if the Town will appropriate money to pay the Town Treasurer and Assessors for their service the year past. The Towns Grant being found short. and to appropriate so much of the money in the Treasurers hand for that service
 - And also to see if the Town will Grant forty shillings to Jabez Luffer of the money in the Treasury to pay him for the Land taken from him for a highway
 10. To hear the a Compt of the Town Treasurer or Chuse a Comitte for him to a Compt with of what money he is accountable for
- And make Return of this order with your Doings here in to the selectmen or Town Clerk at time and place By order of the selectmen of Sudbury
