3. At said meeting the Question was put whether the sheep in said Town may goe at large any part of the Time from the fifteenth of march to the first Day of April and it passed in the Negative
2. To see if the Town will accept of a highway or Town way Laid out by the selectmen on the west side of the River Between the Land of Capt. Richardson & Mr. Rap & running westward to Mr. Uriah Haydens. all is a Town way from the way by Capt. Richardsons a Cross Green hill by Josiah Pratts place where the Proprietors Left Land &c The Town accepted of the afore said ways as the selectmen have Laid them out that they may be Recorded
4. To see if the Town will accept of a highway as the selectmen have Laid out by Amos Sanders is and give him the old way in Exchange it passed in the affirmative as the selectmen have Laid it out and that it may be Recorded
5. The Question was put to see if the Town will free Mr. Eliab Row from highway work the present year for Reasons mentioned & it passed in the Negative
6. To see if the Town will Discontinue a highway sometime past Laid out by the selectmen of Sudbury between the Land of Joseph Goodenow & the Land formerly Jonathan Grounts and accept of the old Town way in Lye there of so that the way first Laid out & discontinued may for the future be and Remain an open highway as it was first Laid out: and it passed in the affirmative and the Town by a vote gave Eliab moore the way discontinued in Exchange for his Right in the old way &c
7. The Question was put to see if the Town will Discontinue a highway formerly Laid out by the selectmen of said Town and accepted by the Town Leading over whales bridge on to the pine plain and the Town by a vote Discontinued that part of the way where it goes in Mr. Heard field or pasture from the Range way till it comes in to the Range way again
8. The Question was put to see if the Town will Dismiss their Comitte (to wit) at this time (to wit) Ephraim Curtis Capt. Thomas Damon & Mr. Jonathan Smith who were appointed by the Town of Sudbury to sell and to direct any person or persons out of Possession of any of their Land in the thirty Rod Highways so called in the new Grant as set forth in an articall in the warning of said meeting and it passed in the Negative
9. To see if the Town will appropriate money to pay the Town Treasurer and assessors for their service the year past the Towns Grant being found short and to appropriate so much of the money in the Treasurers hand for that service as the selectmen shall find still wanting all to the Town appropriated forty shillings of the money in the Treasurers hand for to pay Jabez Puffer for his Land taken from him for a highway in full for his Land &c
10. The Town heard the Town Treasurer Read some of his accounts but did not appoint a Cominitte to settle with him at this Time The Town by a vote ordered their meeting to Monday the sixteenth Day of march Current. to meet at the House of Mr. Augustus moore in said Sudbury in order to finish the work set forth in the warning of said meeting to meet at three of the Clock in the after noon &c
