on Wednesday the twenty seventh Day of May Current & so
to be in duty during their Session & Sessions & Directes
In the Precept Sent to the Town
 - 2 To See if the Town will By their Vote Give Leave that if
Swine in the Town may Go at Large of year Ensuing
 - 3 To See if the Town will Prepare the Highways in the Town By a
Tax or Rate of year Ensuing as they did of year past &
Grant money for the Same
 - 4 To See if the Town will Impower their Committee Person & Impower
Direct By Law any Person or Persons ^{out of} any of the thirty Road
Highways in the New Grants so Caled & to Sell the Same &
To Agree With a Committee Whom of Camers of the Road Highway
shall Apoint for that Purpose and to Enable the Towns Com^{rs}
so Chosen & Impowered to Give Lawfull Acquittances of their
Claims to the Highways as occasion may be in the Towns Name
as also to here the accompts of the Com^{rs} & to see if the Town will
Accept them — Also to see if the Town will Grant or appropriate
a Suficant Sum of Money to Enable the Com^{rs} or any other
Com^{rs} they shall Chuse for that Purpose to Procure the said
in Law to final Effect as the Town shall see Cause
 - 5 To See if the Town will free those that live on the Farm where
Mr Thomas Bond & Mrs. Hisk live from Paying their Part of the
Tax all ready made or that may be yett made ^{for Repairing the Highways} during the Towns
Pleasure Considering of Grate Charge they are at in Renting &
Supporting a Bridge
 - 6 To See if the Town will Chuse a Committee & Impower them to Settle Compts
with the late Town Treasurers & make Report to the Town as
soon as may be and make Due Return to the Selectmen
at time & Place within Mentioned
